## **RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES**

Structured programs are provided for landowners and their guests. The programs are designed for all age groups and skill levels and usually have no fees. To obtain information about the programs, please contact the Landowners Assn. (673-4931).

## **NORTH CLUBHOUSE AND SWIMMING POOL**

The North Clubhouse is available for use by landowner groups on a reservation basis. The Clubhouse has a capacity of 150 persons, with a full kitchen and adequate tables and chairs. All reservations are handled through the Landowners Office.

The swimming pool is operated on a seasonal basis from May to September. The facility serves as an important component of the summer recreation programs which range from swimming lessons to special events.

## **SEVEN LAKES RIDING STABLES.....673-4738**

This facility operates year round. It is open to all landowners and their guests on a reservation system. The facility provides trail rides, general ring rides, pony rides, a riding lesson program and horse shows. Programs are planned for all age groups and skill levels. To make reservations or obtain more information, call 673-4738.

## **OTHER ACTIVITIES**

Fishing is allowed in all lakes, with no North Carolina fishing license required. Boating is open on all lakes with permits. Permits for all North side lakes are issued at the Landowners Office and permits for Lake Auman are issued from West Side Landowners Office. Gasoline engines may be used ONLY on Lake Auman, Lake Sequoia and Echo Lake. Boating regulations govern the use of the lakes. Copies of regulations are available at the Landowners Office for all North side lakes and at the West Side Landowners Office for Lake Auman.

**SEVEN LAKES RACQUET CLUB (Part of SLCC).....673-1096**

The Racquet Club has six Har Tru courts, two of which are lighted. The club house has locker rooms and shower facilities. Instruction programs are given year round – free to members, both adults and juniors. Leagues are available for adults and juniors at all skill levels. Monthly socials are held to complement both recreational play and member-member interactions. These monthly events are supplemented with extra-club season complete with food and playing exhibition of area pros. Yearly memberships are available.

**SEVEN LAKES HEALTH & FITNESS.....673-1180**

This privately owned facility offers a complete line of Nautilus machines, indoor swimming pool, sauna, eucalyptus room, and hot tub. Exercise classes are offered throughout the week. There is a membership fee.

**EMERGENCY SERVICES**

**ALL EMERGENCIES -- CALL 911 FIRST**

This number is the Moore County Central Dispatch. The Dispatcher must have the following information:

- Type of problem
- Your name
- Street address
- Homeowner's name, if not your residence
- Call-back phone number
- Location and directions to place of emergency

Remain calm and clearly give Dispatcher an accurate account of the situation. After you have called the Dispatcher, please call Security at 673-4938 (North) or 673-4901 (South) or 673-3120 (West), so that the gate guard can assist emergency personnel in getting to your home quickly. Also, if an emergency occurs at night, put on lights to identify your location.

## AREA INFORMATION AND AGENCIES

Moore County lies in the Sandhills area of North Carolina and is located near the State's geographic center. As of July 1993, the population in the County was 59,232, of which approximately one-third live within the 10 municipalities in the County. Being centrally located in North Carolina, Seven Lakes is within a short driving distance of five major urban areas. Distances from Seven Lakes to these cities are:

Greensboro.....65 miles  
Raleigh.....70 miles  
Fayetteville.....45 miles  
Durham.....75 miles  
Charlotte.....90 miles

The following agencies provide supportive services which can assist newcomers:

**MOORE COUNTY GOVERNMENT:** Located in Carthage, these agencies administer many local programs affecting a new landowner.

**VOTER REGISTRATION:** Moore County Board of Elections, located in the Lewis Bldg, Pinehurst Ave., Carthage, 947-3868 is open 5 days a week from 9 am to 5 pm and will register voters up to a period of 21 days (excluding Saturdays and Sundays) prior to an election. In order to vote, a 30-day residency in Moore County is required, as well as being registered. Seven Lakes is in the Mineral Springs Township, West End precinct, 8th district. For information regarding a local registrar, call 947-3868.

**TAX LISTING:** Real and personal property are listed for tax purposes during the month of January. Schedules and locations for tax listers are announced in area newspapers. For further information, call 947-6387.

**PASSPORTS:** Apply to Clerk of Court, Court House, Carthage, 947-2396.

**MARRIAGE LICENSES:** Apply to Register of Deeds, Court House, Carthage, 947-6370.

**RECREATION DEPARTMENT:** Provides a variety of recreational programs and activities for all ages. For more information and schedules call 947-2504.

**MOORE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF AGING:** Provides services to transport older adults in Moore County, Monday through Friday. This service is provided for medical appointments, human service needs and to nutrition sites. 24-hour notice is required for transportation. Home improvement service to update the condition of an older adult's home for its energy efficiency, safety and structural integrity. Respite care provides temporary relief for the caretaker who cares for an older adult. Call 947-2881.

### AUTOMOBILE REGISTRATION

You are required to obtain North Carolina tags within 30 days of establishing residence in the State. They may be obtained at the license and title office, Town and Country Shopping Center, Route 1, Aberdeen, 944-1303. Annual car inspections are required after obtaining auto registration.

### DRIVER'S LICENSE

Examination for State driver's license is given at the Driver's License Bureau, U.S. 1 South, Aberdeen, Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 5 pm. Sign and vision tests are required in all cases and road and written tests may be required. For further information call 944-7555.
